*REMIND app.

Due to our current situation, you are to be working through Spring Break. We need to work through the break so that it counts towards our 180 days. We provided you with work for 13 days, but are not allowed back in the building to create more work for you. Therefore, we must continue to teach through technology. I cannot teach you any new material, so this current material only will be review/skills, since I cannot reach all of the students at this time.

As we go digital, I will be using Google Classroom. It is an online classroom that the students have been using all year long. They will need access to a computer, tablet, etc. Please have your child log in daily, as I may post questions, or material often. This is also a way for the students to connect with me as we can communicate through this classroom, instead of using Remind all of the time.

Reminders:

*If not done already, continue to work on the i-ready packets sent home. The daily skill packets for ELA/Math should be done each day, according to the day/week. (Skills packets for Week 30 will take you until April 17th)

*Students should be reading for at least 20 minutes a day and then taking AR quizzes.

*Complete ELA and Math and you can add in music, art, gym, STEM, Social Studies, and Science when time allows. Don't stress about having to fit it all in!
